
STATE ISSUES SCHOOL REPORT CARDS, GRAFTON SCHOOLS

“Significantly Exceeds Expectations”

On November 12, 2019 the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (DPI) issued School Report Cards for all public schools in Wisconsin. The School Report Card provides clarity on how well our schools help children learn and graduate ready for college and career. The Report Cards are one part of a statewide accountability system that compares the performance of each district to the state performance.

The Grafton School District achieved the highest accountability rating of “Significantly Exceeds Expectations” for the second year in a row, and ALL district schools achieved the “Exceeds Expectations” rating or the “Significantly Exceeds Expectations” rating.

In comparison to other K-12 districts in the state, the Grafton School District ranked #9 out of 367 districts. This places Grafton in the top 2.5% of all districts across the state. In Ozaukee County, the Grafton School District ranked #2 behind only the Mequon-Thiensville School District. Each of the past four years has seen an improvement in Grafton’s district score.

“The Grafton School District is proud to achieve the highest accountability rating of “Significantly Exceeds Expectations” for the second year in a row on the WI District Report Card,” said Jeff Nelson, Superintendent. “This rating affirms the efforts of our staff to reach our motto of ‘Every Student, Every Day’ and is a result of the priority on learning that our staff, students and parents exhibit on a daily basis.” Dianna Kresovic, Director of Teaching and Learning, further credited the work of the district’s teachers, “We are very proud of our collaborative work across teacher teams in our district to improve our student achievement data. The district’s K-12 teacher leadership team continues to direct our work with a strategic focus on assessment practices that impact instructional decisions each day for our students.”
